



Viral Papilloma Vaccines



- ◆ Autogenous vaccines can be prepared for a single animal without a licence under Veterinary Medicines Directorate (VMD) regulations. The vaccine prepared from papilloma material harvested from an individual animal is used *solely* for the same animal. The animal's ear tag number should be recorded at the time of sampling—this number shall be used to uniquely identify the vaccine.
- ◆ Vaccines prepared on a herd basis using material from several animals require licensing.

Guide to Sampling

- ◆ Pendulous wart material that is relatively easy to collect is acceptable for vaccine preparation.
- ◆ If papillomas are a herd problem, collect material from several individuals.
- ◆ Please note that it will take 6 - 8 weeks to prepare the vaccine. It will be necessary to complete a License Application Form before manufacture commences. Please contact the laboratory for a copy.

Minimum 30 g papilloma material submitted in a plain sterile container (without preservative)
